Bring your favorite vest pattern and choose your Embroidery pattern.</p> <p>1<sup>st</sup> class we will embroider front details of vest fabric</p> <p>2<sup>nd</sup> class we will cut and assemble vest, Fitting and Finishing.</p>	 
Supply list	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Embroidery Machine in good working condition with foot control and power supply</li> <li>• Sewing Machine for second class</li> <li>• hoop size - LARGE.</li> <li>• Stabilizer -Medium weight cut-a-way or No-show Mesh or Sticky one</li> <li>• Temporary Spray adhesive</li> <li>• Blue scotch tape to secure fabric on the hoop</li> <li>• Fabric for vest- suit fabric, wool blend, might be <u>lightly</u> stretchy, not much.</li> <li>• Lining( optional) -silky fabric would be the best.</li> <li>• Notions for cutting, marking and pinning fabric, Tailor's chalk or Frixion Pens</li> </ul> <p>Attention: cut out and iron interfacing to the front of the vest according to your pattern instruction. I recommend you to add 2" extra around all edges of the front pieces. Interfacing should be 2" wider all around.</p> <p>Prior to class: Outline front of vest on fabric using Taylor chalk, iron interfacing to the wrong side and bring it to the class like that. You may cut out the back of the vest though. We are going to cut our front pieces after we embroider it. It's the best strategy to avoid any shrinkage.</p>
