**Tools Needed:**

Phillips Screwdriver  
 Cordless Drill with Clutch  
 (preferred)  
 ½" Wrench

**Parts:**

Lift  
 Lift Wings  
 Switch Plate  
 Switch Cord  
 Power Adapter  
 Power Cord

**Hardware Supplied:**

20x Truss Head Screws  
 4x Small Cord Adapters  
 2x "L" Brackets

1. Start by testing the **Lift**. Plug in the power cord and press on the switch to verify movement in both directions.
2. Place the **Lift Wings** on the **Lift** as shown in figure 1 and fasten them using the **Nuts** provided. Unplug the **Lift**.
3. With the cabinet laying on it's top, be sure to orient the **Lift** as shown in figure 2. Place the **Lift** inside the cabinet. There are two holes on the bottom side of the table top. Line these holes up with the holes on the **Lift**. Insert a screw in each hole. Make sure the screws are tight but **DO NOT STRIP**.
4. With the preferred side of the lift deck facing down, slide the lift deck under the **Lift** and center it in the cabinet opening.
5. Plug in the power cord.
6. Tapping the switch move the **Lift** down until the wings just touch the lift deck.
7. With the lift deck centered in the opening attach the lift deck to the lift wings using Truss Head Screws in the six holes (three on each wing).
8. With help carefully turn the cabinet right side up.
9. Move the bottom of the **Lift** around until the lift deck lines up with the table top. Left to right as well as back to front should be considered.
10. When the lift deck is lined up insert a screw through one of the side holes in the bottom of the **Lift** and into the shelf of the cabinet (*If you use the center hole beware that if the **Lift** gets stuck at the bottom for any reason, it will be difficult to remove*).
11. Check to see if you are still aligned. If not, loosen the screw and repeat step 9.
12. Insert a screw in the other hole.
13. To secure the cords start by fastening the switch and place the **Small Cord Adapters** around the switch cord and fasten them down using the Truss Head Screws in the pre-drilled holes as shown in figure 3.





Wings


