




double hemstitch pintucks with lace

Create pintucks while attaching lace using a double hemstitch needle.

1. Attach lace and create the impression of hemstitching at the same time creating a pintuck. Thread your machine for twin needles. Thread the gimp cord through the top of the cord guide bobbin cover and up through the slot. Place the straight edge of the lace under the center of the pintuck foot so the right needle catches the header when sewing. The wing needle, on the left, will create holes along the edge of the pintuck as you sew. (#1)

Fabric, needles, notions required:

Fine fabrics such as batiste, silk or linen; double wing needle, size 100/16; rayon or cotton embroidery thread for needle and bobbin; gimp cord
