

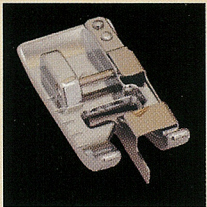
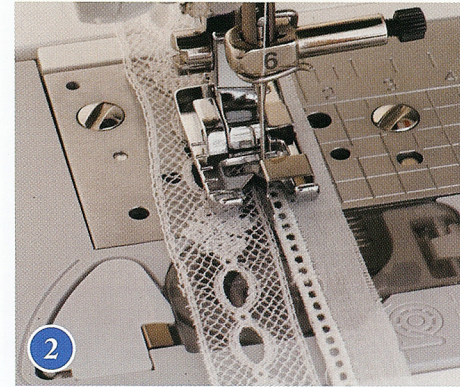
heirloom — attaching lace to entredeux

An heirloom technique used to attached lace to commercial entredeux.

1. Prepare the lace by spraying it with the starch. Trim the fabric lip from one side of the entredeux. (#1)



2. Snap on the edge joining foot and place the lace on one side and the trimmed edge of the entredeux on the other side of the metal blade. Adjust the zigzag stitch length so the needle falls into each hole of the entredeux. Adjust the stitch width if necessary. Sew. (#2)

Stitch: Zigzag

Width: Pre-set

Length: Adjust to size

Tension: Pre-set

Fabric, needles, notions required:

Edging or insertion lace; commercial entredeux; universal needle, size 70/10; rayon or heirloom embroidery thread for needle and bobbin; spray starch
