# Fleece Fringe Scarf

Fleece helps us stay warm all winter long. Create this variation of a winter scarf with your fleece scraps. Make them for the whole family in different combinations to match everyone's winter coat. The Janome Rotary Even Foot makes sewing the layers of fleece a breeze.



# JANOME SUPPLIES REQUIRED

- Any Janome machine
- Rotary Even Foot
- Blue Tip needle 75/11

# FABRIC AND NOTIONS REQUIRED

- 1/4 yd. plaid fleece
- 1/8 yd. red solid fleece
- 1/8 yd. blue solid fleece
- All purpose thread

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

### **Fabric Preparation**

- 1. Cut two 4 1/2" x 9" pieces from the red solid fleece.
- 2. Cut two 4 1/2" x 9" pieces from the blue solid fleece.

#### Instructions

- 1. Set up your machine for ordinary sewing.
- 2. Attach the Rotary Even foot.
- 3. Fold each solid piece in half lengthwise.
- 4. Sew along the center of the folded strips.
- 5. Layer one of each color on either side of the plaid fleece along bottom edge.
- 6. Sew close to the previously sewn seam. Be sure to stitch through all layers.
- 7. Repeat on other end of scarf.
- 8. Cut the layers at even increments to fringe edges.
