Some panels only require a small amount of fabric such as a fat quarter. There are detailed cutting instructions inside.</p>

You may use more colors than the sample – and/or use fat quarters and scraps (not for the lining). You have written instructions, but there is room in this class for you to do your own thing and use your creativity. ● Soft and Stable – 1 yard (36" x 58") <p>Specialty Supplies:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 6 ½ yards - 8/32 Cord (Cording for straps) – 6 strips 38" long ● 5 yards - 1/8" Piping ● 12" zipper ● 1 yard ¼" elastic ● 4 Self cover buttons – 7/8" size ● Dritz Fray Check * ● Dritz 6 Looped Needle Threaders * ● Topstitch needles and regular needles for your serger (Bring more than one just to be safe!) * ● Temporary Spray Adhesive – Any brand will do! * ● 24" of decorative trim (Will be used to "fill" the decorative flatlock stitching you'll be using on the tote. Consider decorative trims that work with your decorative threads.) ● Thread Supplies: Glamour by Madeira Serger (looper) Decorative threads Have fun with your thread selections! When you select your decorative threads, consider contrasting colors because you want your work to stand out. <p>General Supplies: *</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Clips or Pins, Hand Sewing Needle, Small Scissors.
