Class description	Learn how to quilt your own quilts using your single needle machine. You will learn the elements of getting a perfectly balanced stitch, how to free motion, and stipple.
Prior to Class	 We recommend taking the class, "Know Your Feet, Pt. 5" on May 9, prior to taking this class. Clean, oil and put a new needle in your machine. Become familiar with your machine. Review your manual if necessary. If your machine does not have a drop feed dog option then bring a throat plate cover. If your machine does not have a plate, a small square of template plastic or a business card will do the trick. Determine if your machine has a low, high or slant shank. This information is needed to purchase the machine feet listed below. If your machine has not been serviced within a year's time, then do so prior to class. Mechanical problems with your machine can not be addressed in class, so preventive maintenance is best.
Supply list	 Quilt as Desired, Your guide to Straight-Line and Free-Motion Quilting (available in store) <i>Kit</i>: A kit will be available for \$10 that includes a 20" square predrawn white muslin mini quilt that has been basted to backing and batting. Also included is the binding and hanging sleeve. Sewing Machine Extension table for your machine (if you have one). An extension table for your machine is helpful for machine quilting. These are portable Plexiglas or wood mini tables that surround your machine and are level with the arm of your machine. It increases the surface area you need for your hands to maneuver the fabric. These can be purchased at the store but may need to be specially ordered for your machine type. Scissors Thread: Quality sewing thread- 1 spool and 2 bobbins with neutral or white color thread, 1 spool with bright color thread

	 Bobbins: 1 bobbin wound with thread contrasting to bright color and 2 bobbins wound with white thread Machine accessories Manual Needles: Schmetz Universal 80/12 (bring extra) Quilter's Gloves 1⁄4" Foot Walking Foot Blank paper and pencil for notes Free Motion/stippling foot
