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TECHNIQUE S	SEWING	TALK ABOUT
OVERCAST STITCHES	FABRIC: Sweatshirt fleece with an inside curve cut across one edge and one piece of ribbing, folded in half.	The overcast stitches sew a seam and finish edges in one easy step.
	SELECT: Turn dial to closed overcast stitch. SET: Snap on the Blindhem Foot, 3. Stitch length: S1 Stitch width: 5 Tension: 3 - 7 SEW: Lay the ribbing onto the curved edge, stretching it slightly and matching the raw edges.	 Use the same stitch for seams on stretch fabrics. Your SMARTER BY PFAFF™ 160s sewing machine has different overcast stitches so you can choose the right stitch for your technique.
	Sew along the curved edge, with the right swing of the needle off the edge of the fabric.	
STITCHES	FABRIC: Medium weight woven fabric with stabilizer. SELECT: Turn dial to the open scallop stitch. SET: Snap on the Clearview Foot, 1. Stitch length: buttonhole area	 Your SMARTER BY PFAFF™ 160s sewing machine has decorative stitches to make your project special. Use specialty threads to give a whole different look to your stitches.
