

ALL ABOUT the invisible zipper foot

Another type of zipper application hides the zipper completely. There is no stitching showing on the right side of the garment or craft. A special zipper foot with two grooves (1) on the bottom was designed to hold the coils of the invisible zipper in place while sewing.

Inserted into an open seam, each side of the zipper is sewn to the seam allowances separately. Since the invisible zipper foot has such a small needle hole, the center needle position is used when sewing the zipper.
