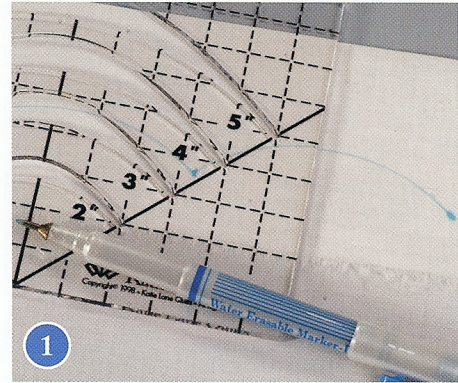


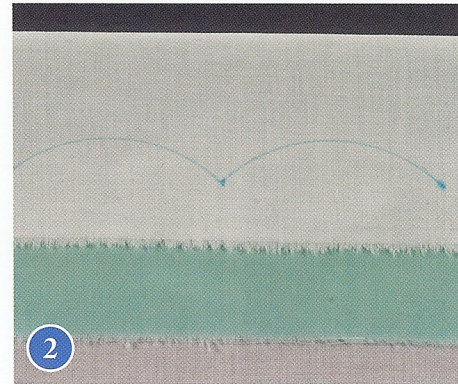
hems — shadow

An elegant hem finish for fine linens, heirloom garments or children's clothes.

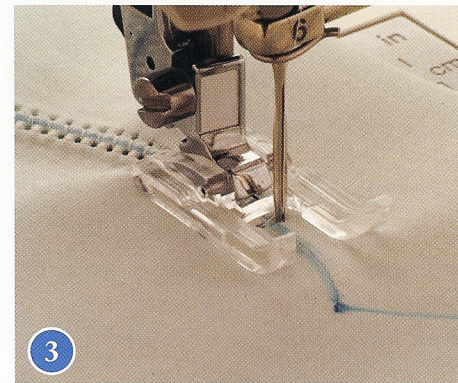
1. Prepare the fabrics with spray starch. Turn up a 2-1/2" to 3" hem to the wrong side; press. From the right side using a scallop template, mark scallops 1-1/2" from the folded edge using a water-soluble marking pen. (#1)



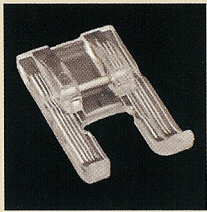
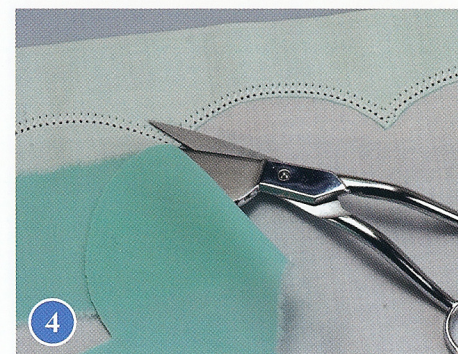
2. Slide another layer of the same fabric or a darker-colored fabric under the hem and up to the fold. (#2)



3. Insert a wing needle. From the right side, center the foot over the line and begin stitching with the pinstitch through all the layers. (#3)



4. From the reverse side, carefully trim away the remaining hem and the colored fabric, close to the stitching. (#4)

Fabric, needles, notions required:

Fine fabrics such as batiste or light-weight linen; wing needle, size 100 or 110; rayon or heirloom embroidery thread for needle and bobbin; spray starch; water-soluble marking pen; scallop template; appliqué scissors
