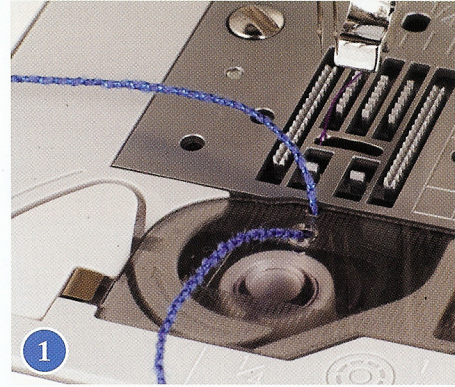


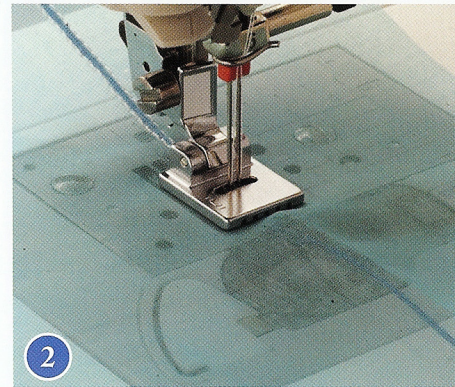
shadow pintucks

Use a darker colored filler cord or bobbin thread to create shadow pintucks on sheer fabrics.

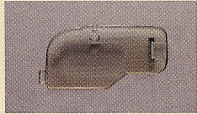
1. Thread the darker cord through the cord guide bobbin cover from the top and up through the slot. (#1)



2. Set your machine for twin needle sewing and snap on the pintuck foot. Begin sewing as many rows of shadow pintucks as desired.

Stitch: *Straight*

Width: *Pre-set*

Length: *Pre-set*

Tension: *Pre-set*

Fabric, needles, notions required:

Sheer fabrics; twin needle, size 2.0/80; all-purpose sewing, rayon or cotton embroidery thread for the needle and bobbin; gimp cord

TIP

Use a darker bobbin thread to sew uncorded pintucks. The bobbin thread will zigzag back and forth as the stitch is being sewn and create a shadow effect through the sheer fabric.
