

tucks — bubble

A unique textural effect created by tacking tucks at intervals making “bubbles”.

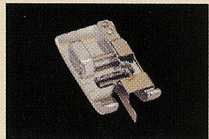
1. Evenly space and press in the tucks, wrong sides together. Using the edge joining foot, adjust the needle position for very narrow tucks. Sew at least three tucks. (#1)



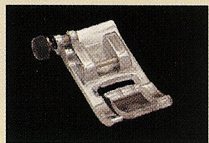
2. Once the tucks are sewn, match the edges of two tucks and bartack them together at random intervals using the standard foot. (#2)



3. Gently steam the tucks from the wrong side to create a bubbly effect. There is no right or wrong to this technique so press or steam the tucks as you desire.

Stitch: *Straight and Zigzag*

Width: *Pre-set and 2.5mm*

Length: *Pre-set and 0.0mm*

Tension: *Pre-set*

Fabric, needles, notions required:

Fabrics of choice; universal needle, size 80/12; all-purpose sewing thread for needle and bobbin

FOOT FACTS

Use the edge joining foot to make perfect 1/8" tucks by moving the needle position to the far left. Place the fabric along the metal blade and sew.
