







Seth **Aaron Makeup Bag**

MATERIALS: Brother CE1100PRW' 8 1/2" x 11" piece of white paper; 12" x 9" piece of black leather for exterior; 12" x 9" piece of fabric for interior, 12" of nylon webbing; 12" of elastic; scissors; D-rings; chalk pen; ruler; straight pins




Pin pattern to both pieces of fabric and cut.













Pin elastic down the middle of the inside of the fabric.





With your chalk pen and ruler, mark 1" marks for larger brushes and 1/2" marks for smaller brushes. These marks are your sewing lines.





Set your Brother CE1100PRW to stitch "02" and sew your marked lines to create brush holders.







Pin both the outside and inside fabrics together, face-to-face.





Set your Brother CE1100PRW to stitch "01" and sew the two fabrics together. Be sure to leave a 4" opening on one side of the case.






Turn your case inside out.









Iron the edges flat.






Then pin across the outside edge.







Set your Brother CE1100PRW to the stitch you would like to enhance your case. For this project, I used stitch "30". Sew along the outside edge of the case.







Take your piece of nylon and fold through the D-rings and pin to the center of one outside edge of the case. Use stitch "02" to sew the nylon to the case.





Roll your case up and you're all set!
