You need:

- Grey silk fabric 20 x 20 cm (8" x 8")
- Pink fabric as lining 20 x 20 cm (8" x 8")
- Chenille band in light and dark pink
- Grey Ribbon of sequins 60 cm (23 5/8")
- Grey sewing thread
- Pink sewing thread
- Fabric marker
- Invisible sewing thread
- Fusible interfacing
- Chenille foot

1 (3/8") cm seam allowance is included in the pattern.

1 Paper Pattern

The full-sized pattern can be found on the following layout design.
Cut out the pattern.

2 Cutting

Silk fabric:	1 piece
Lining fabric:	1 piece
Fusible interfacing	1 piece

3 Sewing

Iron the fusible interfacing on the wrong side of the silk fabric.
Take the fabric marker and draw diagonal lines on the silk fabric, this will be help lines during the sewing.

Embellish your project with chenille effects by using the Chenille Foot. This foot will easily guide and stitch layers of chenille strips wherever you want a chenille effect.

1. Thread your machine with regular sewing thread on top and in the bobbin.
2. Select a straight stitch or a zigzag stitch. Use a short stitch length and a narrow stitch width. Another suggestion is three-step zigzag, stitch width set to 1.5
3. Place the strips in the presser foot as the pictures show. Use three layers of the chenille strips to create a beautiful effect!
4. Snap on the Chenille Foot.
5. Engage IDT.
6. Sew carefully. The Chenille Foot will guide the chenille strips onto the fabric where you want to have the chenille effect with the stitch forming in the middle of the strips. (You might need stabilizer underneath the fabric.)
7. Add more rows of chenille strips in the same way, to complete your project.
8. Rub the strips with a stiff brush to fray.

Sew the sequins in place. Thread your sewing machine with invisible sewing thread in the top and crème sewing thread in the bobbin. Select a hand look appliqué stitch and sew it in place.

Fold the decorated piece right side together and stitch around the side and the bottom. Trim the seam allowance to 5 mm and turn it inside out.

Repeat this on the lining, but leave an opening in the bottom.

Pin the decorated piece and the lining with right side together, stitch around the upper edge. Turn it inside out throw the opening in the lining. Close the opening with some stitches by machine.
